CERPI's are a new type of publicly-listed security designed to resemble limited partnership interests of typical international private equity funds. This first-of-its-kind transaction will likely open the door for new CERPI offerings which will co-exist with the more traditional CKD funds, thereby creating a more flexible and modern investment offering for Mexican institutional and other qualified investors.
